June 3rd, 2020 - salvador dalí was born on 11 may 1904 at 8 45 am on the first floor of carrer monturiol 20 in the town of figueres in the empordà region close to the french border in catalonia spain dalí's older brother who had also been named salvador born 12 october 1901 had died of gastroenteritis nine months earlier on 1 august 1903 his father salvador rafael aniceto dalí cusí 1872'
